Jesus, sweetest Child, who through Your Virgin Mother, visited St. Elizabeth, and filled Your forerunner, the holy Baptist, with the Holy Spirit, sanctifying him while yet in his mother’s womb; **have mercy on us.**

December 28 Third Day—The Nativity

“She gave birth to her firstborn son and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger.” Luke 2:7

Jesus, sweetest Child, born in Bethlehem of Mary ever Virgin, wrapped in swaddling clothes, laid in the manger, announced by angels, visited by shepherds; **have mercy on us.**

O Little King, attraction of all hearts, we hail that blessed hour and moment in which You were born of the most pure Virgin Mary in the poverty of Bethlehem. December 29 Fourth Day—The Holy Name

December 30 Fifth Day—The Adoration of the Magi

“The wise men from the East saw the child with Mary his mother, and they fell down

and worshipped him. Then, opening their treasures, they offered him gifts, gold and frankincense and myrrh.” Matthew 2:11

Jesus, sweetest Child, made known to the three wise men by a star, adored in the arms of Your Mother, presented with the mystic gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh; **have mercy on us.**

Let us pray

O Babe of Bethlehem, with the wise men we acknowledge You to be our Sovereign Lord. December 31 Sixth Day—The Presentation

“When the time came for their purification according to the law of Moses, they brought him up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord.” Luke 2:22

Jesus, sweetest Child, presented in the Temple by Your Virgin Mother, embraced by Simeon, and revealed to Israel by Anna the prophetess; **have mercy on us.**

Let us pray

January 1 Seventh Day—The Flight into Egypt

“An angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream and said: ‘Rise, take the child and his mother, and flee to Egypt.’” Matthew 2:13
